Cars in car parks on arrival and departure; during session	Run over	medium	All	Parents drop off/collect their child/ren and walk them through the car park and down the alley way between Ancells Farm Community Centre and the Vets. Then they cross a driveway to a smaller car park. Tell Beavers not to enter the car park once we have responsibility for them, unless we walk them across.	
Sitting on the pavement to draw with chalk	Run over	medium	All Beavers	Adults to stand at set points to monitor no child steps into the car park.	
Children getting lost	Children could wander off	low	All Beavers	Adults to warn children of risks at start. Children told to stay in eyesight of leader when playing games and within set parameters.

Members of the public	Child could be taken or injured	low	All Beavers	Adults to be vigilant. No member of the public allowed to talk to our Beavers. If they try to, an adult answers for the child. If strangers move close to our children, a leader asks them to move away and we may move our children away from them.	
Dog mess	Health hazard	low	All	Adults to warn children to avoid if they notice dog mess and tell leaders if they see any	
Uneven ground, twigs, branches, woodland	Trip hazard	low	All	Adults to warn children to avoid if they notice potholes, large puddles, large roots, tree branches or trunks.	
Dogs	Child may get bitten	medium	All	Dogs will probably not be on leads. Remind Beavers NOT to stroke any dogs and Leaders/adults to be vigilant if we pass any dogs or any approach us.	
Cyclists	Knocked over	low	All	Beavers should stay on the grass or path at all times, not be on the road.	
Litter	Pick up something disgusting	low	.All	Tell Beavers not to pick up litter unless they dropped it.	
Walking to Woodland	More opportunity for all of the risks above	low	All	Walk with an adult at the very front and very back, with other adults spread out amongst the children.
